2. The present application has been filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. for quashing of the order taking cognizance dated 23.01.2017 in connection with Complaint Case No.483C of 2016, whereby cognizance has been taken by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sheikhpura under Sections 386, 341, 323, 427,384/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 27 of the Arms Act.
