2 23-04-2025 Heard learned counsel appearing on behalf of the
petitioner and learned APP appearing on behalf of the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends her arrest in a case
registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the
Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per prosecution case, 14.895 litres illicit liquor
has been recovered from the house of this petitioner.

4. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner
submits that petitioner is innocent and has falsely been
implicated in this case. No incriminating material has been
recovered from the conscious possession of this petitioner and
he is in no way connected with the aforesaid recovery.

5. On the other hand, learned APP appearing for the



State submits that petitioner is not entitled to the privilege of anticipatory bail in view of decision of the Full Bench of this Hon'ble Court rendered in the case of *Ram Vinay Yadav vs. The State of Bihar* reported in *2019(2) P.L.J.R. 1089 (F.B.)*. Petitioner has also got three criminal antecedents of similar nature.

6. Considering the aforesaid decision of this Court and fact that petitioner has got three criminal antecedents of similar nature, the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to this petitioner is rejected.
