ORAL ORDER

2 07-05-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the Informant as well as learned A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Mahkar P.S. Case No. 188 of 2024 dated 17.11.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 80, 238 read with section 3(5) of the BNS Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, the petitioner and the co-accused persons are alleged to have killed the informant's daughter by electric shock due to non-fulfillment of demand of Rs. 1.5 lakhs as dowry.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in



this case. The petitioner is the mother-in-law of the deceased. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner. The petitioner neither demanded any dowry nor tortured the deceased. The husband of the deceased is in custody. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 04.01.2025.

5. Learned counsel for the Informant as well as learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Gaya in connection with Mahkar P.S. Case No. 188 of 2024.

7. The application stands allowed.
