2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Dhanaha P.S. Case No. 17/2025 dated 18.01.2025 registered for the offence punishable u/s 8, 20(b)(ii)(B) of the N.D.P.S. Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 4 kgs. Ganja was recovered from the dicky of the motorcycle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The seized contraband is less than commercial quantity. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since



19.01.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, West Champaran at Bettiah in connection with Dhanaha P.S. Case No. 17/2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
