2      17-04-2025      Heard Mr. Hira Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner  
and Mr. Choubey Jawahar, learned APP for the State.

2.      The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Excise  
PS Case No. 96 of 2025 instituted for the offences under  
Sections 30(a), 32, 41 & 56(b) of the Bihar Prohibition and  
Excise Act.

3.      The prosecution case, in short, is that 534.240 liters  
country made liquor was recovered from Bolero pickup van.

4.      Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the  
present case. No incriminating material has been recovered from  
the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has got  
no concern with the alleged recovery of liquor. Learned counsel



for the petitioner submits that the name of the petitioner has surfaced in this case as being driver of the vehicle in question and he was oblivious of the fact that illicit liquor was laden in the vehicle. The petitioner is in custody since 20-01-2025 and has got no criminal antecedent. There is no compliance of Section 103 of the BNSS, 2023.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, clean antecedent of the petitioner and the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Excise PS Case No. 96 of 2025.
