2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for offence under Sections 143(1), 145, 98, 3(5), 75, 79 of the B.N.S., 2023, Section 8 of the POCSO Act, Sections 75, 79 of J.J.Act, Sections 3, 4, 5, 6 of I.T.P.Act and Sections 16,17,18 of Bonded Labour System Act, 1976.

3. As per prosecution case, on 07.12.2024, during raid at Shobha Orchestra, four minor girls were recovered and upon inquiry, the girls disclosed that they were brought by this petitioner to perform dance in orchestra, but they (girls) were tortured by petitioner and others to do immoral acts. In paragraph – 27 of the case diary also, the statement of victims



girls were recorded under Section 180 B.N.S.S., in which, they have fully supported the prosecution case. The victims are minor.

4. Considering the nature of accusation and statement of the victim girls recorded under Section 180 B.N.S.S., the prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioner is rejected.
