7 22-08-2025 It is submitted by the learned counsel appearing for the Bhupendra Narayan Mandal University, Madhepura that the date of substantive appointment of the petitioners has been shifted back long ago, hence they were required to file appropriate application in the prescribed format along with all the requisite documents so that the same could be placed before



the Selection Committee for considering their cases for shifting their date of promotion accordingly, however, a simple one page application has been filed which does not bear any details, whatsoever.
