ORAL ORDER

2 17-04-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and
learned A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Excise Nawada P.S. Case No. 52/2025 dated 25.01.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a) and 47 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 90 litres of illicit foreign liquor from two cars and from the room of community hall. Further, 32 litres of illicit country-made liquor was recovered from the room of the community hall and sugarcane field.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted



that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. As per para. 13 of the bail petition, the petitioner has no concern with the said vehicles. The other co-accused person has already been granted bail by this court *vide* order dated 09.04.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 18580/2025. The petitioner has one antecedent in which he is on bail as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 26.01.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Nawada in connection with Excise Nawada P.S. Case No. 52/2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
