A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for  
grant of regular bail in connection with Ghorasahan P.S. Case  
No. 31 of 2025 dated 22.01.2025 registered for the offences  
punishable u/ss 317(4), 317(5) of the BNS and sections 30(a),  
41(1) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 405 litres of illicit  
Nepali liquor kept in three sack tied with the motorcycle was  
recovered and 14.91 litres of foreign liquor and 8.7 litres of  
Nepali country made liquor were recovered from the house of  
the petitioner.



4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner is neither the driver nor the owner of the said vehicle. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has one criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 07.02.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, East Champaran, Motihari in connection with Ghorasahan P.S. Case No. 31 of 2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
