2 23-04-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Magadh University P.S. Case No. 17/2025 dated 26.01.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a) and 45 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act and Sections 126(2), 132, 115(2), 121(2), 324(4) read with Section 3(5) of the B.N.S.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 10 litres of illicit country-made liquor was recovered from the house of the co-accused, Vijay Choudhary.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in



this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 27.01.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Gaya in connection with Magadh University P.S. Case No. 17/2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
