2 24-06-2025 Heard Mr. Navjot Yesu, learned counsel for the appellants, Mr. Naresh Dikshit, learned counsel for the Respondent No. 2 and Mr. Binay Krishna, learned Spl.P.P. for the State.

2. Mr. Naresh Dikshit, learned counsel for the Respondent No. 2 informed this Court that the appellants had already filed Cr. Writ Jurisdiction Case No. 548 of 2025 and the appellants have been granted stay in arrest in connection with Anandpur P.S. Case No. 13 of 2025 vide order dated 11.04.2025.



3. In view of the aforesaid, the present appeal is not maintainable as the appellants have no apprehension of arrest.
