petitioners and learned APP appearing on behalf of the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence punishable under Sections 420 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per prosecution case, it is alleged that the complainant in total gave Rs. 83,000/- to Petitioner No. 1 in his bank account from C.S.P., Gaurishankar Bharti at Chanaua for sending the complainant outside India for employment but neither the accused persons sent him outside the country nor



returned the money. Petitioners have got two criminal antecedents.

4. Considering the specific and direct nature of accusation and criminal antecedents of the petitioners, the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners is rejected.
