A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 80, 61(2), 3(5) of B.N.S., 2023 and Sections 3, 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

3. As per prosecution case, daughter of informant was married with co-accused Santosh Yadav on 22.05.2024 and after the marriage, she was subjected to cruelty and harassment by the accused persons including petitioners for dowry and lastly, she was killed.

4. Petitioner no. 1 is father-in-law and petitioner no. 2 is mother-in-law of the deceased. There is general and omnibus



allegation. Thrust of the accusation is against husband of the deceased, who has already surrendered in the Court below on 30.05.2025 and since then, he is in custody. Petitioners are separate in mess and property and have got no concern with the family affairs of deceased and her husband.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State vehemently opposes the prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioners.

6. However, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances, let the above named petitioners, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned A.C.J.M. - I, Hilsa, District - Nalanda in connection with Hilsa P.S. Case No. 479 of 2024, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S., 2023.
