3 08-08-2025 The present petition has been filed for restoration of a writ petition bearing C.W.J.C. No. 18671 of 2023, which has stood dismissed for want of prosecution vide order dated 10.09.2024.

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that counsel for the petitioner could not reach the Court in time due to heavy traffic
