A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioners apprehend their arrest in a case registered for the offence under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 109, 303(2), 352, 351(2)(3), 3(5) of B.N.S., 2023.

3. As per F.I.R., petitioner no. 2 (Mithun Kewat) assaulted informant with knife, causing grievous injury to her.

4. Considering the nature of injury, the prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioner no. 2 (Mithun Kewat) is rejected.

5. So far as prayer for anticipatory bail of petitioner no. 1 (Leela Devi) is concerned, since there is general and omnibus allegation, no specific allegation of overt act has been



alleged against her and the fact that petitioner no. 1 is lady, having clean antecedent, in the event of arrest/surrender within a period of eight weeks from today, let petitioner no. 1 namely Leela Devi be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Khagaria in connection with Alauli P.S. Case No. 531 of 2024, subject to condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S., 2023.

6. This application is, accordingly, disposed of.
