ORAL ORDER

2 01-05-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Nawada P.S. Case No. 682/2021 dated 01.07.2021 registered for the offences punishable u/s 33, 34 and 36 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, the allegation against the petitioner is to be involved in the trade/business of spurious liquor, where one person died after consumption of spurious liquor.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in



this case. The other co-accused person have been granted bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this court vide order dated 13.12.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 84041/2024. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R, the name of the petitioner has sprung up in the confessional statement of the co-accused, Arvind Yadav. The petitioner has 17 antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 12.11.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Nawada in connection with Nawada P.S. Case No. 682/2021, with the conditions:-

(i). The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bonds of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.



(ii). If the petitioner is found involved in similar nature of offence in the future, the prosecution will be at liberty to move for cancellation of his bail bonds.

7. The application stands allowed.
