After some argument, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw this writ application with liberty to the petitioner to file a statutory appeal under Section 67(1) and 67(2) of the Bihar Mineral (Concession, Prevention of Illegal Mining, Transportation & Storage) Rules, 2019 and if the petitioner files the appeal within a period of four weeks, the Appellate Authority is directed to



consider the appeal of the petitioner on its own merits without being prejudiced by this order and pass a reasoned order after hearing the petitioner within a period of eight weeks taking into consideration that the matter was pending since 2022.

3. Permission is accorded.

4. Accordingly, this writ application stands dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
