ORAL ORDER

2 24-06-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Lalganj P.S. Case No. 429 of 2023 dated 10.12.2023 registered for the offences punishable u/s 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 320 litres of illicit liquor was recovered from two places. Out of which, 120 litres of illicit liquor was recovered from the Bhatti near pachsiya pond and 200 litres of illicit liquor was recovered near the Taraknath Temple situated at Kanjaha Chak.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged



recovery. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. It is submitted that local chowkidar disclosed the name of the petitioner. The petitioner has six criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 25.02.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, in connection with Lalganj P.S. Case No. 429 of 2023 with following conditions:

(i) the petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates with reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.

7. This application is allowed.
