2. Considering the nature of allegation, I find that the

matter can be resolved outside the Court amicably by way of

mediation.

3. The petitioner is directed to appear before the

learned District Court on 11.09.2025 at 10.30 am.

4. Learned District Court is directed to take necessary

action to refer the matter before the learned mediator of the

District Mediation Center.

5. Learned Mediator of the District Mediation Center



concerned shall make his/her best efforts to settle the dispute amicably and thereafter submit his/her report before the concerned learned District Court, well within a period of four months, till then, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner in connection with Piprakothi P.S. Case No. 18 of 2015.

6. Learned mediator must be more concerned about the five children belonging to the petitioner and opposite party no. 2. They should not be left orphan and for this reason also, the petitioner is liable to show his concern.

7. In case of failure on the part of the petitioner to appear on 11.09.2025 at 10.30 am. before the learned District Court or any date fixed by the learned Mediator, the interim protection granted to the petitioner shall automatically lose its force and the District Court may take appropriate action in accordance with law.

8. Accordingly, the present bail application stands disposed of.
