Perused the report of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patna dated 27.05.2025 wherein it has been mentioned that the appellant of the aforesaid appeal namely, Dev Nath Mistry has died and in support thereof, a report of the Inspector of Police-cum-Officer-Incharge, Parsa Bazar PS dated 28.01.2024 has been enclosed regarding the factum of death of the sole appellant.
