ORAL ORDER

2 13-05-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Town P.S. Case No. 592/2024 dated 25.09.2024 registered for the offence punishable u/s 303(2), 317(2), 317(5), 111, 338, 336(3), 313 and 61(2) of the B.N.S.

3. As per the prosecution case, the allegation against the petitioner and the co-accused persons are of committing theft of motorcycle and thereafter, selling the same to the other accused persons.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted



that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The other co-accused persons have already been granted bail by the Co-ordinate Bench *vide* order dated 08.04.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 8642/2025. The petitioner has four antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 27.09.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner by submitting that a motorcycle was recovered from the possession of the petitioner and one motorcycle without registration number was recovered from the house of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Muzaffarpur in connection with Town P.S. Case No. 592/2024, with the condition :-

(i). The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable



cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
