3 29-08-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for
offence under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. Name of the
petitioner transpired during course of investigation in the re-
statement of informant. F.I.R. has been lodged after a delay of 8
days without any plausible explanation of delay. Petitioner has
got clean antecedent and is in custody since 29.01.2025.
Chargesheet has been submitted.

4. Learned A.P.P. for the State vehemently opposed
the bail petition.

5. Considering the period of custody and clean
antecedent, let the above named petitioner be released on bail on



furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Araria in connection with Araria P.S. Case No. 136 of 2024.
