ORAL ORDER

2 06-05-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Darauli P.S. Case No. 360 of 2024 dated 14.11.2024 registered for the offences punishable u/s 309(4) read with Section 3(5) of the B.N.S.

3. As per the prosecution case, four unknown miscreants ridden on two motorcycles are alleged to have stopped the informant's motorcycle and started abusing and assaulting him. It is further alleged that they put the weapon on the informant's head and snatched his motorcycle and one mobile phone of Oppo company.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted



that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner. The petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. The name of the petitioner has sprung up in the confessional statement of the co-accused, Rahul Kumar Yadav. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. No T.I.P. has been conducted by the prosecution. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged offence. The petitioner has nine criminal antecedents as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 17.12.2024.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, Siwan in connection with Darauli P.S. Case No. 360 of 2024 with the condition :-

(i) The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable



cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.

7. The application stands allowed.
