ORAL ORDER

4 18-08-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
counsel for the informant and learned A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for
grant of regular bail in connection with Govindganj P.S. Case
No. 143 of 2024 dated 01.04.2024 registered for the offences
punishable u/s 341, 323, 324, 307, 302, 504, 506 read with
section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. As per the prosecution case, when the informant's
son went to his poultry farm, in the meantime the petitioner and
the co-accused persons were assaulting him. Thereafter, the
informant came there to give food to his son then all the co-
accused persons tried to catch her with an intent to commit



murder, but on halla, all the accused persons fled away. The informant's son died during the course of the treatment.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. There is general and omnibus allegation against the petitioner. The other co-accused persons have already been granted bail by this court *vide* order dated 08.07.2024 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 43627/2024. The petitioner has clean antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 25.01.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State as well as learned counsel for the informant have vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner. As per the post-mortem report, the cause of death is due to intracranial haemorrhage and injuries, caused by heavy, hard and blunt substance.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned, East Champaran at Motihari in connection with



Govindganj P.S. Case No. 143 of 2024, with the condition ;-

(i). The petitioner is directed to remain physically present before the learned Court below on each and every date, failing which on two consecutive dates without reasonable cause, the bail bond of the petitioner is liable to be cancelled.

(ii). The petitioner is directed to co-operate in the trial before the learned court below.

7. The application stands allowed.
