ORAL ORDER

2 05-05-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
A.P.P. for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Madanpur P.S. Case No. 90 of 2025 dated 25.02.2025 registered for the offences punishable u/ss 30(a), 34 and 36 of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 480 litres of illicit spirit was recovered from the Maruti Car.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The petitioner is not the owner rather the co-accused, Mukesh Kumar is the owner of the seized vehicle. The petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner



has no criminal antecedent as stated in para 3 of the bail petition.
The petitioner is in custody since 25.02.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed
the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of
the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner above-
named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond
of Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand) with two sureties of the
like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Court concerned,
Aurangabad in connection with Madanpur P.S. Case No. 90 of
2025.

7. The application stands allowed.
