appellant has died. Resultantly the present appeal stands abated.

However, certain claims are being made by the legal heir of the

appellant with biological father-respondent.

are not entitled to anything in the present proceedings. Our
endeavor has completed in not extending any relief to the
children of deceased – appellant and respondent - Awadhesh
Kumar Sinha (father).

4. Legal heirs of appellant and children of respondent are at liberty to invoke appropriate remedy for the purpose of claiming any monetary or property from the respondent.
