ORAL ORDER

3 05-08-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
APP for the State and learned counsel for the complainant.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Complaint Case No. 872 of 2021, instituted for the offences
punishable under Section 498(A) of the Indian Penal Code and
Section 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the
complainant was tortured and harassed by the petitioner and
other co-accused persons due to non-fulfillment of demand of
dowry.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the
present case. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that



the allegation levelled against the petitioner is general and omnibus in nature. The allegation alleged against the petitioner is completely false and concocted based on without any legal evidence. The petitioner has been implicated in this case due to non-execution of the landed property in her name. The petitioner is in custody since 23.01.2025 and has got no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP for the State and learned counsel for the complainant have vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and taking into account the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Complaint Case No. 872 of 2021.
