2 30-04-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with
Morkahi P.S. Case No. 121 of 2024 instituted for the offences
under Sections 25(1-b)a, 25(1-AA), 26, 35 of the Arms Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, a mini gun factory was
raided by the police party near Bagmati River, leading to the
arrest of three persons including this petitioner and seizure of
illegal arms and other equipments.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the
petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. No
incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious
possession of the petitioner rather the recovery has been made
from an open place near the bank of Bagmati river. Learned
counsel further submitted that petitioner has got no concern with



the recovered arms and ammunitions. Charge-sheet has been submitted in this case. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 19.08.2024 and has no criminal antecedent. There is no compliance of Section 103 of the Bharatiya Nagarika Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. The co-accused person has already been granted bail by this Court vide order dated 05.03.2025 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 12764 of 2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, claim based on parity as also the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Morkahi P.S. Case No. 121 of 2024.
