ORAL ORDER

3 30-07-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
APP for the State and perused the case diary.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with S.
Kamal P.S. Case No. 435 of 2024, instituted for the offences
punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 352, 351(1), 351(2),
109(1), 3(5) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Section
27 of the Arms Act.

3. The prosecution case, in short, is that the petitioner
along with other co-accused persons have fired upon the
informant due to which he sustained injuries.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in the



present case. Charge-sheet has been submitted in this case. No incriminating material has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. Learned counsel for the petitioner also submits that no specific allegation has been attributed against the petitioner rather the same is general and omnibus in nature. It is further submitted that the injuries received by the informant is simple in nature caused by hard and blunt object. The petitioner is in custody since 30.12.2024 and has got four criminal antecedents.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and taking into account the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with S. Kamal P.S. Case No. 435 of 2024, subject to the following conditions:

(I) One of the bailors shall be own/close member of the family of the petitioner.



(II) The petitioner shall appear on each and every date fixed at the trial. In case of default in such appearance on two consecutive dates, the Trial Court will have liberty to cancel the bail bonds of the petitioner.
