ORAL ORDER

2 30-04-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and

learned A.P.P for the State.

2. The petitioner has preferred this application for grant of regular bail in connection with Excise P.S. Case No. 192 of 2025 dated 23.03.2025 registered for the offence punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, total 36 litres of illicit country made liquor was recovered from the sack tied with the motorcycle.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in this case due to his previous antecedents. Nothing has been



recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner. The motorcycle in question does not belong to the petitioner and petitioner has no concern with the alleged recovery. The petitioner has three criminal antecedents of similar nature as stated in paragraph no. 3 of the bail petition. The petitioner is in custody since 24.03.2025.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the bail petition of the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as well as the period of custody, the petitioner, above-named, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail-bond of Rs. 20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Exclusive Special Judge Excise-II, Nawada, in connection with **Excise P.S. Case No. 192 of 2025.**

7. The application stands allowed.
