learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.

3. As per the prosecution case, 119.325 litres of illicit foreign liquor has been recovered from Bolero.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has clean antecedent and he has falsely been implicated in the present case. Nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner and petitioner has no concern at all with the alleged recovery.

5. Learned APP for the State has opposed the bail



petition and submits that petitioner is the owner of the Bolero in question.

6. Considering the quantity of recovery and the fact that petitioner is registered owner of the Bolero from which the said recovery has been effected, the prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is rejected.
