submits that the Circle Officer, Morwa, District-Samastipur has

already passed the final order under Section 6(1) of the Bihar

Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956 on 03.08.2023 in

connection with Encroachment Case No. 29 of 2022-23,



whereby and whereunder it has been found that the land in question is a raiyati land, hence encroachment proceedings have been dropped.

2. At this juncture, the learned counsel for the petitioner seeks liberty on behalf of the petitioner to challenge the aforesaid order dated 03.08.2023, by taking recourse to the due process of law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.
