ORAL ORDER

- 2 16-07-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.
2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 30(a), 32(i), 32(iii) of Bihar Prohibition and Excise Act.
3. As per prosecution case, total 16.02 liters illicit liquor was recovered from two seized motorcycles and petitioner is owner of one of the motorcycles.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no incriminating material has been recovered from conscious possession of the petitioner. Petitioner has got no concern with the alleged recovery and he has been made accused in this case only on suspicion. Petitioner claims clean antecedent.
5. Learned A.P.P. for the State opposes the prayer for bail of the petitioner.



6. Considering the fact that petitioner is owner of the seized motorcycle from which illicit liquor has been recovered, prayer for anticipatory bail of the petitioner is refused.
