2. The present petition has been preferred for the following relief(s):

(A) To quash the order dated 10.11.2014 passed by Dr. K.P. Ramaiah, the Member Administrative, Bihar Land Tribunal, Patna, in BLT Case No.- 383/2014, a copy of which is annexed as Annexure-.5, to this writ application, as well as the order dated 22.01.1998, passed by Deputy Director of Consolidation, Vaishali at



Hazipur in Appeal case No.-250/97 a copy of which is annexed as Annexure-3, to this writ application and confirm the order dated 2.08.2013, passed by the Director consolidation, Bihar Patna, in Consolidation Revision Case No.-311/2012, a copy of which is annexed as Annexure-4, to this writ application and also the order dated 7.02.1987, passed by Consolidation Officer, Bidupur, in Case No.- 3/87, a copy of which is annexed as Annexure-2, to this writ application.

(B) To stay the operation of the order dated 10.11.2014, passed by the Member Administrative, Bihar Land Tribunal, Patna, in BLT Case No.-383/2014, till disposal of this writ application.

(c) To pass such any other order/orders as this Hon'ble Court may think fit and proper under facts and circumstances of this case.”
