2. The petitioners have filed the instant application for the following relief(s) :-

“1. That by this writ petition the petitioners pray for quashing of the order contained in Memo No. 1268[4] dated 04.08.2008 by which the respondents in the most illegal manner rejected the claim of joining of the petitioners and in the most illegal manner has held that the appointment of the petitioners is illegal as there was no advertisement whereas according to the Health manual for the purpose of appointment of Dresser after due training by department no fresh advertisement is required. This writ petition is filed as per the order dated 01.12.2011 passed in M.J.C. No3727 of 2011.
