ORAL ORDER

5 19-09-2025 At the outset, the learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though the order of this Court dated 2.9.2022, passed in CWJC No. 4980 of 2021 has stood substantially complied with, but as far as Madan Sahni and Punydev Chaudhary are concerned, the petitioner be granted liberty to challenge the settlement (*Bandobasti*) made in their favour, by taking recourse to the due process of law, if the same is



permissible under the law. Liberty, so sought, is granted.

2. Accordingly, the present contempt petition stands disposed off.
