W.P.(C) No. 720 of 2025** decided on 20.01.2025 or any other judgments relied within a period of two weeks thereof. Any orders passed shall be communicated to the parties.

3. Till such time the authorities take a decision the possession of the petitioner shall not be disturbed.

4. With the above direction, the Writ Petition stands disposed of.
