ORAL ORDER

2 17-06-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Barahat
P.S. Case No. 20 of 2025 corresponding to GR No. 151 of 2025
instituted for the offences under Sections 25(1-b)a, 26, 35 of the
Arms Act.

3. As per the F.I.R., one country-made pistol and seven
live cartridges have been recovered from the house of the co-
accused Tarani Chauhan and this petitioner was also
apprehended on the spot.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the
petitioner has falsely been implicated in the present case. No
incriminating article has been recovered from the conscious



possession of the petitioner rather the recovery has been made from the house of the co-accused namely Tarani Chauhan. Learned counsel further submitted that petitioner has got no concern with the recovered arms and ammunitions. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 15.01.2025 and has no criminal antecedent. There is no compliance of Section 103 of the Bharatiya Nagarika Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.

5. Learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case as also the period of custody undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

7. Let the petitioner be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Barahat P.S. Case No. 20 of 2025 corresponding to GR No. 151 of 2025.
