2.The present petition has been preferred for the

Respondent to pay the compensation
for the Homestead land in the light of
letter no. 37 dated 9.1.2016 issued by
the Respondent concerned determining
the rate of Rs.2,32,58,760/- (Two crore
thirty two lac fifty eight thousand seven
hundred sixty rupees only) for the
homestead land as per section 26 of the
RFCTLARR Act, 2013 together with*



other benefits provided under the Act.
