2 29-04-2025 Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner Mr. Rajeev Shekhar as well as Mr. Mukesh Kumar Thakur, learned counsel appearing for the Bihar State Election Authority and Mr. Sarvesh Kumar Singh, learned counsel appearing for the State.

2. After making some submissions, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawing the present writ petition with liberty to challenge the final result of the election, in case



the same goes against him, under Section 48 of Bihar Co-operative Societies Act, 1935.

3. This prayer being made by the learned counsel for the petitioner is not opposed by the learned counsel for the respondents.
