ORAL ORDER

3 11-08-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State. Perused the case diary.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Hajipur
Town P.S. Case No. 564 of 2024 instituted for the offences
under Sections 302(2), 317(5) of the Bhartiya Nyaya Sanhita,
2023.

3. As per prosecution case, the police has apprehended
the petitioner with the stolen Wagon R Maruti Car.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the
petitioner is innocent and has committed no offence as alleged
against him and has falsely been implicated in the present case
due to local party politics. Learned counsel for the petitioner
submits that as per prosecution case, the alleged Wagon R car is



without number but, as a matter of fact, the seized car was purchased by the petitioner from Mantu Rai on 02.06.2024 in writing on stamp paper. There is a non-compliance of Section 103 of the B.N.S.S. which creates a serious doubt in the prosecution case. The petitioner has two criminal antecedents and in both of them, he is on bail and is languishing in judicial custody since 04.08.2024 without any rhymes or reason. Charge-sheet has been submitted in this case.

5. On the other hand, learned A.P.P. for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of bail to the petitioner.

6. Having heard rival contention of both the parties and considering the entire facts and circumstances of the case as also taking into account the period of custody of the petitioner, let the petitioner, abovenamed, be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.15,000/- (Fifteen thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Court below/concerned Court in connection with Hajipur Town P.S. Case No. 564 of 2024.
