ORAL ORDER

2 09-07-2025 Heard Mr. Deepak Kumar Singh, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners and Mr. Nagendra Prasad, learned APP for the State.

2. The petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in connection with Khanpur P.S. Case No. 152 of 2024 registered for the offence punishable under Sections 126(2), 115(2), 117(2), 109, 351(2) and 3(5) of the BNS.

3. As per the allegation made in the F.I.R., all the accused including the petitioners with a common intention to kill assaulted the informant and her family members causing injury on the vital part of the body.

4. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the



petitioners submitted that the petitioners and the informant are own family members and due to family dispute, both the parties indulged in fierce fight, in which, the petitioners might have caused some injury to informant's side, which was in self defence without any intention. Petitioners have clean antecedent. Allegation being general and omnibus, the petitioners seek to be released on pre-arrest bail.

5. Learned APP for the State has vehemently opposed the prayer for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioners.

6. Having considered the rival submissions made on behalf of the parties, as well as, on perusal of the F.I.R., I find that the allegation levelled against the petitioners is general and omnibus, the petitioners, above named, are directed to be released on pre-arrest bail, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of four weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned J.M.F.C. cum Munsif, Samastipur in connection with Khanpur P.S. Case No. 152 of 2024, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.

7. The District Court is directed to verify the criminal antecedent of the petitioners and if it is found that the petitioners



are involved in some other cases as what has been stated in
Para-3 of the bail petition, this order will automatically lose its
force.

8. The bail application stands disposed of.
