ORAL ORDER

4 17-07-2025 1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, learned
APP for the State and learned counsel for the Vigilance.

2. The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Kalyanpur P.S. Case no.322 of 2024 registered under
sections 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120B of the Indian Penal Code.

3. The allegation in the F.I.R is that the petitioner was
appointed as a Block Teacher on the basis of false and fabricated
document.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
petitioner was appointed in the year 2015 and has worked till
16.06.2025 with an unblemished record and without any notice
the action has been taken against him. Further, a supplementary



affidavit has been filed by the petitioner stating therein that petitioner now stands terminated vide letter dated 16.06.2025. The petitioner has no criminal antecedent and undertakes to cooperate in the case/trial.

5. The application for anticipatory bail is opposed by learned A.P.P. for the State and learned counsel for the Vigilance on the ground that petitioner did not resign during the amnesty period.

6. Taking into consideration the fact that petitioner is now terminated, it is directed that the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of four weeks, be released on anticipatory bail in connection with Kalyanpur P.S. Case no.322 of 2024 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Court below where the case is pending/successor Court, subject to the condition laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure/Section 482(2) of the B.N.S.S, 2023.
