2. This application has been filed for seeking
following reliefs:

*i. To issue an appropriate writ/s,
order/s or direction/s for commanding the*



respondents to institute a high level enquiry by a specialized Agency to enquired Sahodara P.S. Case No. 62 of 2024 dated 21.06.2024 for registered offences under sections 363 366A, 504/34 of Indian Penal Code whereby and under the FIR named accused persons were kidnapped the minor daughter of the petitioner and still traceless.

ii. To issue further appropriate writ/s, order/s or direction/s commanding the respondents to take all punitive legal action upon the petition dated 02.07.2025 as well as 09.07.2024 and other application filed by the petitioner before the Respondent No. 4 to 6 to recovered the Minor daughter of the informant in the hands of accused in connection with Sahodara P.S. Case No. 62 of 2024.
