2. The present writ petition has been preferred for:

*quashing the awarded dated
16.05.2016 in L.A. case no. 17(IV)/2009-10
passed under "Right to Fair compensation
and Transparency in Land Acquisition,
Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013
which is amended award dated 04.01.2013
under section 3G of the national Highway
Act, 1956 under Gazette notification dated
8.12.2010 without following mandatory
requirements under section 24(2) of the*



RFCTLARR Act, 2013.
