2. The petitioner has challenged the legality / validity
of the order dated 06.01.2015 passed in Eviction Suit No. 34 of
2007 under Section 15 of the BBC Act (Annexure-7) and bare
perusal of the operative part of the said order dated 06.01.2015
passed in Eviction Suit No. 34 of 2007 observes that:
