The petitioner, who is working as a Panchayat Teacher in Government Primary School, Jahli Tola, Hariharpur Lalgah, Block – Barharia, has filed this writ petition for payment of salary from 15.11.2014 to June, 2020; October, 2020 to December, 2020; July, 2021; January, 2022 to March, 2022 and further from July, 2022 onwards.

as such in Government Primary School, Jahli Tola, Hariharpur
