ORAL ORDER

4 17-03-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.
Despite valid service of notice, nobody appears for opposite
party no.2.

2. Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered for
the offence punishable under sections 341, 323, 379, 406, 420,
384, 506 and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that
both parties have resolved and settled their dispute in terms of
settlement mutually agreed upon by them. A copy of the
settlement is annexed with the mediator's report dated
25.2.2025.

4. Learned counsel for opposite party no.2 does not
controvert the submission of the learned counsel for the
petitioner.

5. Considering the mediator's report, prayer for bail
of the petitioner is allowed. In the event of arrest/surrender



within six weeks from today, let the petitioner, mentioned above, be enlarged on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate 1st class, Saharsa in Complaint Case No. 544 of 2023, subject to the conditions laid down under section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure as well as in terms of settlement.
