APP for the State.

2. The petitioner has prayed for regular bail in a case registered for the offence punishable under sections 30(a) of the Bihar Prohibition and Excise Amendment Act, 2018.

3. The case of the prosecution is that from the cattle food of the petitioner, altogether 70.92 liters of country made foreign liquor was recovered.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is innocent and has falsely been implicated in connection with the present case. It is further submitted that nothing has been recovered from the conscious possession of the petitioner rather the same has been recovered from the cattle food. Moreover, the petitioner is languishing in judicial custody



since 11.04.2025 having no criminal antecedent.

5. Learned APP appearing for the state has opposed the prayer of regular bail.

6. Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this court is inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. The above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail in connection with Patory Exccise P.S. Case No.49 of 2025 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Special Judge (Excise)-II, Samastipur.
