ORAL ORDER

2 19-06-2025 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned APP
for the State.

2. The petitioner seeks bail in connection with Kishanganj P.S. Case No. 302 of 2024 instituted for the offence under Sections 318(4), 336(3) & 336(4) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 and Sections 8(c) & 21(c) of the NDPS Act. Earlier vide order dated 24-10-2024, passed in Cr. Misc. No. 76030 of 2024 regular bail of the petitioner was rejected by this Court.

3. Prosecution case pertains to recovery of 261.660 gram smack as also Rs. 1,42,000/-.

4. It has been mainly submitted on behalf of the petitioner that the petitioner is in custody since 10-08-2024 and



petitioner is a lady. Learned counsel for the petitioner next submits that there is no likelihood of the trial being concluded in the near future.

5. Learned APP for the State opposes the prayer for bail and submits that bail of the petitioner was earlier decided on merit and she does not deserve the privilege of bail.

6. After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, this Court does not find any fresh ground to reconsider the matter, which is already decided by this Court on merit. Accordingly, prayer for bail of the petitioner is once again *rejected*.

7. The Trial Court is directed to expedite the trial as expeditiously as possible without any undue delay and unnecessary adjournments.
